## My Vacation Check–Off List

- Shot Records\*
  - Distemper/Parvo Combination Vaccination
  - Rabies
  - Bordetella (Kennel Cough)
    - Give your own vaccinations? See Bottom\*\*
  - Cat's – Rabies and Distemper
- Toys, Bedding and/or Crates
  - Please bring items that can be easily laundered, Bring extras so they always have something with them while others are being cleaned.
- Food and Treats
  - We do provide a dry kibble free of charge, but encourage their own food be brought to keep from getting upset stomachs
  - Bowls are provided
  - No Rawhides are allowed
- Medication – Given free of charge
  - To help keep this a free service and to avoid extra time and confusion, please supply medication in the following manor.
    - Meds must be brought in either prescription bottle, weekly planner cases or zip-lock baggies
    - Pills must be already split if only receiving ½ or ¼ pills
    - Always bring an extra day or two just in case
    - Bring written instructions for administering medications (see our Pet Care Info Form)
- Cats
  - We provide kitty litter, litter boxes and bowls.
  - Food is not provided
- Is your dog afraid of storms?
  - Please bring medications that we need to give in order to keep them calm.
  - You will be held responsible for any damage done to the kennel or themselves should they become destructive due to their fears.

\*Please provide print out from vet. Vaccination Booklets will not be accepted as proof of vaccinations. Please note that Pets will be turned away if vaccinations cannot be proven or have expired. Vet can fax records to 330-547-7534. Vaccinations must be received at least "48" hours before boarding.

\*\*The following must be provided: The receipt showing the vaccinations purchased.

The bottles, labels or packaging that shows name of vaccination, expiration date and lot number.

Date vaccination given. (This applies to Bordetella and Distemper/Parvo Only! Rabies, by law, must be given by a licensed vet. )
